DxF Updates

- SB 660 has been passed by the legislature and signed by Governor Gavin Newsom. The legislation makes targeted updates to the Data Exchange Framework's (DxF) governance, implementation, and administration, clarifies definitions, and specifies certain compliance provisions. More information will be released soon about upcoming activities as a result of the legislation.

- HCAI have begun our final TAC meeting series for 2025 discussing Identity Management on DxF. Last week's first meeting explored the components of Identity Management important for DxF, and began to define and prioritize the issues DxF should address.
- We will continue that discussion in the coming weeks and discuss areas where Identity Management is working well in California and other states and recommendations for future DxF actions in Identity Management.

STANDARDS ADVANCEMENT:

- As a reminder, the [Data Elements to Be Exchanged P&P v1.2](#) has been amended to update USCDI requirements to version 3 effective January 1, 2026, as recommended by the 2024 Standards Committee and to align with federal health IT certification requirements.
